SES Literacy Tutor

POSITION ROLE:

Reporting to the SES Program Specialists, this position is responsible for tutoring academically at-risk students perform better in school by providing literacy/reading tutoring. Specifically, tutors will be working with 1 to 3 students from Kindergarten through eighth grade students in the student's home or at a community site.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Establish and maintain tutoring schedule with families
- 2) Tutor 1 to 3 students per session, in the student's home or at a community site
- 3) Meet goals of program,
 - a. Assist students in improving their reading skills by one grade level by the end of the program.
 - b. Ensure students complete number of allocated tutoring sessions
- 4) Follow lesson plans and/or develop individualized literacy activities for students
- 5) Complete and submit student logs and other paperwork on attendance and student progress
- 6) Other related tasks

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1) Completed a **minimum** of 48 college units or paraprofessional certificate
- 2) Literacy tutoring experience and depth of knowledge about literacy/reading development
- 3) Ability to read and write in English fluently
- 4) Able to work productively and effectively with children
- 5) Self starter, ability to work independently and with little supervision
- 6) Ability to manage students' behavior and engage students in daily lesson
- 7) High degree of motivation, initiative, and energy
- 8) Flexibility and leadership skills, but also a willingness to take direction
- 9) Good communication, verbal and written skills
- 10) A strong sense of commitment and reliability

ESSENTIAL SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

Liberal Studies and/or Education related major, preferred; experience working with children in literacy tutoring. Must be able to work afternoons and early evenings Monday – Friday; and Saturdays

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:
